Election Position Descriptions and Requirements

AUXILIARY SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE One position available, One year term

The Auxiliary Services Advisory Committee (ASAC) is responsible for making recommendations for ensuring the quality, availability and cost-efficiency of services on campus. The committee also is charged with making recommendations regarding new services for the college and with reviewing the operation of such services.

The committee will serve as a resource to the Associate Vice President for Auxiliary Services, the Vice President for Finance and Management and the Vice President for Student Affairs on issues regarding vendor compliance, bookstore, food services, laundry, and residence hall services and vending.

The committee will conduct an annual survey on food service, the bookstore and other issues related to auxiliary services. Further, the committee will act as a conduit for the campus community to the auxiliary services management.

The committee will file an annual report to the President of the college and to the chair of the College Senate regarding the state of campus auxiliary services, and will include its recommendations.

In order to be a candidate for this position the following requirements must be fulfilled:

- Must hold a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.
- Candidates must currently be matriculated undergraduate students enrolled full time and have no Conduct violations or outstanding Conduct sanctions.
