Election Position Descriptions and Requirements

** INFORMATION ON BECOMING A STUDENT MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF FSA ** Two positions available, Two year terms

The student members of the Board shall be elected (by plurality) by those students eligible to vote in the annual Student Government election process. A student who wishes to be a candidate:

1. Shall file a written application with the Office of Student Life prior to the deadline established by Student Government for their general elections.

<u>Term of Office</u> - The term of office shall be for two years.

<u>Duties and Powers</u> - The board consists of (8) members, three (3) of which are students. The board reviews applications for grants from students and faculty to conduct educational and social programs **on campus**. The board also approves a budget annually to fund these grants and operational expenses.

Meetings – The board meets on average two (2) times per academic semester.

In order to be a candidate for this position the following requirements must be fulfilled:

- Candidates must currently be matriculated undergraduate students enrolled full time and have no Conduct violations or outstanding Conduct sanctions.
- *Please Note there is a separate election for the graduate student positions conducted through the Graduate Student Association. For more information please see http://gsa.buffalostate.edu/. Both the undergraduate and graduate election results will be tallied to see who won the student Faculty Student Association positions.
 - Must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.
