Election Position Descriptions and Requirements

****GRANT ALLOCATION COMMITTEE*** Three undergraduate student positions And one *graduate student position available. All positions are for two-year terms.

The Grant Allocation Committee (GAC) is charged with soliciting and reviewing proposals for campus programs and activities, and for distributing those funds allocated to support them, with a goal of enriching the intellectual, social and cultural needs of the Buffalo State community.

The committee will file an annual report to the President of the College and to the chair of the College Senate detailing the allocation of funds, and will include its recommendations.

G.A.C. Composition

Faculty – Each faculty shall elect one member to the committee.

Staff and Librarians – The Professional Staff Caucus shall elect one member to the committee, and the librarians shall elect one member.

Terms of Office

Faculty, Staff, and Librarians: Each committee member shall serve for a two-year term, up to four consecutive years.

Students: Students shall be elected or appointed for two-year terms but may not be reelected or appointed for more than four years.

Chair: The chair of the committee will be appointed for a two-year term.

In order to be a candidate for this position the following requirements must be fulfilled:

Candidates need not be an activity fee-paying student to be eligible for these positions.

<u>Candidates must currently be matriculated undergraduate students enrolled full time and have no</u> Conduct violations or outstanding Conduct sanctions.
